## Genesis 6-9

### “Good to Knows” from Noah’s Story

- 10<sup>th</sup> generation from Adam
- He had godly ancestors: Methuselah (the oldest), Lamech (Gen. 4)
- Noah’s name means comfort or rest
- Noah lived 950 years (Genesis 9:28)
- Noah obeys God and constructs an ark (100-120 yrs) (Gen. 6)
- There were 8 people on the Ark
- It rained 40 days and 40 nights
- Noah was on the ark approx. 370 days
- Many cultures (about 200) in the world have a flood story.
- According to dimensions researchers believe the Ark could hold up to 70,000 animals.
- Noah worshiped God after coming out of the ark (Gen. 8)
- God promises to never flood the earth again, rainbow is the sign (Gen. 9)
- Noah sins through drunkenness, his son shames him (Gen. 9)
