*“Learning to Follow by Sitting with Him.”*

Mark 1:35-39

### 1. Everyone Didn't \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ for Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_.

*Before daybreak the next morning, Jesus got up and went out to an isolated place to pray.... “Everyone is looking for you!”*

Mark 1:35 & 37 NIV

It is more often than not a seductive fallacy that says I need to do this, whatever “this” might be, more than I need to be in the presence of Christ. This seduction lets me believe that I need to do more than I need to be with Jesus.

## 2. Everyone \_\_\_\_\_ from Each of Us \_\_\_\_\_ with God.

*Very early in the morning while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.*

Mark 1:35 NIV

Truth is, we are all better when we have been with Jesus.”

### The Power-Filled Benefits of Devotions

...And by him we cry, “Abba, Father.” Romans 8:15 NIV

The Lord said, “Go out and stand on the mountain in the presence of the Lord, for the Lord is about to pass by.” 1 Kings 19:9-11 NIV

**B.** \_\_\_\_\_  
*hallowed (Holy) be your name,*

“You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God...

Exodus 20:7 NIV

Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name,<sup>10</sup> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow... Philippians 2:9-11 NIV

*your kingdom come,  
your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.*

But Jesus replied, “We must go on to other towns as well, and I will preach to them, too. That is why I came.” Mark 1:38 NLT
